While not a highly active year at the state level in terms of real property tax legislation, the State Legislature has passed some important legislation that local municipalities/school districts should consider. The process of delivering bills for the Governor's consideration is beyond comprehension so not all bills have been delivered/signed yet.

As it currently stands, #1 below is something that you could adopt immediately. However, if you wish to provide an exemption as outlined in #2, you must wait until the bill is delivered to and signed by Governor Hochul.

1. S3085-A & A3956-A – Increased Limits for Senior/Disability Exemptions (signed into law 8/8)

The last time that NYS allowed local taxing jurisdictions to increase the exemption scale was in 2007. This now provides for an increase in the scale from a low income of \$29,000 to \$50,000 to receive a 50% reduction on your property taxes. As a result of NYS taking over the Enhanced STAR qualification, I don't have complete information to determine how much a change might affect the overall tax base.

Tompkins County will take up a resolution to increase the income limit for a 50% exemption to \$35,000 from \$29,000. It is anticipated that this change will shift about \$5 in taxes to the median house. Your municipality/school district can choose any income limit that is appropriate for your community. Please contact me if you have any questions or need some analysis completed.

Attached are the current scales for all the taxing jurisdictions.

2. S.9131 & A10155-A – Volunteer Firefighter & Ambulance Workers

There had been discussion in the county about the need to ask the state for special legislation that would allow you to pass an exemption for Volunteer Firefighter and Ambulance Workers for Tompkins County's municipalities. However, NYS did a crazy thing and passed new legislation that combined the 22 different sections that offer this type of exemption into a single statute that would be applied uniformly across NYS. This legislation would allow for a 10% reduction in assessed value for approved applicants. Tompkins County would need to determine a process of determining certification procedures for volunteer firefighters. This section gives me pause as it cedes my authority to grant to exemptions to someone else but with the assistance of DOER, hopefully we can determine a process that is fair and equitable. In addition, the exemption can offer the exemption for the surviving spouse of either a volunteer who died in the line of duty, or a surviving spouse of a deceased volunteer
